

SPANISH Art and Painting course at Övedskloster: August 10<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> , 2010

For five days in August this year, the Spanish artist **Chema Rodríguez**, *Profesor colaborador de Dibujo del Natural. Facultad de Bellas Artes de Sevilla*, will visit Övedskloster for this exclusive course in history of art and painting. This young painter (born 1976) visited Övedskloster for the first time some years ago and has returned to Sweden many times since then to paint commissioned portraits. His classical style in soft Mediterranean colours has a modern and very personal touch. You will stay in single or double rooms at Övedskloster, one of the most important 18<sup>th</sup> century castles in Sweden. A maximum of fourteen guests will be accepted, to ensure that each person has enough exclusive teaching time with Chema. You can choose to work in oils or water colors, as a beginner or more advanced, but still eager to develop your work. You bring your own painting material; paint, canvas, brushes and so on. There will also be lectures of art history, paint techniques and more, depending on your interest. In the evenings different activities will be available, such as yoga, guided walks, or just relaxed socializing with the other guests. On the final evening there will be an exhibition and a special dinner when you can invite your own guests (maximum two per person).
